# Hands off Drummoyne Water Tower

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales.

# The petition of residents of the City of Canada Bay/ New South Wales brings to the attention of the House:

- The proposed sale of significant Sydney landmark and heritage site, Drummoyne Reservoir and Tower, located at Rawson Avenue Drummoyne via the open market by Sydney Water.
- Drummoyne Reservoir is only reservoir with its tower surviving in Sydney and is listed both on the State Heritage Inventory and in the NSW State Heritage Register.
- The sale of the site on the open market could lead to a number of undesirable consequences including that the heritage reservoir could be demolished and, worst case scenario, replaced by high density residential development.
- The site was decommissioned in 1994 and is in need of repair and remediation before it would be suitable for public use.

- Retain Drummoyne Reservoir and Tower as a public asset by bestowing it to the City of Canada Bay Council.

- Sanction City of Canada Bay Council's proposal to develop a Conservation Management Plan for the adaptive reuse of the reservoir, and the residue land to be used as a public park following handover.
