McIlwaine Park: Playground and Park Upgrades

As part of our commitment to improving local infrastructure, Council is pleased to advise that we are commencing upgrades to McIlwaine Park Playground this July as part of our wider \$1.4 million McIlwaine Park Upgrade.

The project aligns with Council's 'Let's All Play Strategy' and will transform the existing playground with a new rubber soft fall surface, play tower, swings, slides, musical instruments, and more.

Works are anticipated to be completed in **October 2024**, weather permitting.

During construction, the playground will be closed for use. Other nearby play areas are located at the Rhodes 5 Senses Garden, Phoenix Park, and Peg Paterson Park.

Our \$1.4 million McIlwaine Park Upgrade also includes the construction of a new amenities building and pathways, refurbishment of the Putt Putt golf course, and installation of additional picnic shelters and barbecues.

Work will be carried out between Monday–Friday from 7am–5pm; however, there may be instances that will require work to be undertaken outside of these hours.
